**1. Rhodes Wellness College alumni who have earned a certificate** in Coaching or counseling or higher are eligible for acceptance into a Sofia University Bachelor's program when one of the two conditions below is satisfied:

- 1) The student meets the General Education requirements for Bachelor of Art degrees offered through state universities in the State of California.
- 2) The transfer credits have been evaluated and deemed acceptable by Sofia University.
- 3) Student holds BA or advanced level education.

Rhodes Wellness College AAS graduates who meet one of these conditions will be admitted into Sofia University provided they meet all admissions requirements for the applicable program as determined by Sofia University.

**2. Rhodes Wellness College students without an Associate's Degree** who wish to transfer to Sofia University will have all college-level/non-remedial courses completed at Rhodes Wellness College with a grade of "C-" or better, and which do not duplicate other credits earned by student, accepted for transfer as either an elective, General Education requirement, or an exemption or replacement for a required course as deemed appropriate in accordance with Sofia University current transfer credit policies.

Rhodes Wellness College students wishing to transfer to Sofia University are subject to all applicable Sofia University deadlines and policies and procedures of Sofia University.

**Upper Division Transfer Students:**

Rhodes Wellness College students who transfer lower-division credits beyond that required for an associate's degree, or whose lower-division credits are equivalent to designated upper-division course content, may have these courses evaluated by Sofia University registrar and, where appropriate, they will be applied toward the course in the major.

Rhodes Wellness College students who hold additional education (BA, or advanced degrees) may use relevant education to transfer in to MBA or PhD programs. Registrar for transfer will review all transfer credits. A NACES accredited evaluator may be required for advanced degree enrollment.

*Note: Lower-division credits transferred to satisfy upper-division courses do not constitute completion of the 30 upper-division credits required for graduation. Therefore, even if upper-division courses are awarded, Rhodes Wellness College students will still need to obtain a minimum of 30 upper-division credits at Sofia University to meet graduation requirements.*

### Maximum Number of Transferable Credits

The maximum number of transfer credits that can be accepted and applied toward degree completion is 90 credit hours.
