

Annual Notice of Availability of Consumer Information

Consumer information is updated on an annual basis and made available to enrolled and prospective students and staff of Sofia University electronically online at www.sofia.edu by clicking on “Consumer Information,” from the main home page. **Paper copies of the consumer information are available upon request** from the Admissions Office.

Notice of Privacy of Student Records – Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA): Students have the right to review their education records, to request amendment of records, to consent to disclosures of personally identifiable information, and to file complaints with the Department of Education. Procedures for reviewing records and the institution’s policy regarding disclosures of information are located on the school’s web site.

Copyright Infringement Policies and Sanctions (including computer use and file sharing): Unauthorized distribution of copyrighted material, including unauthorized peer-to-peer file sharing, may subject students to civil and criminal liabilities. Additional information regarding penalties associated with unauthorized distribution of copyrighted materials is located on the school’s web site.

Drug and Alcohol Abuse Prevention: Sofia University has adopted a zero tolerance policy regarding the unlawful use, sale, possession, and/or distribution of drugs and alcohol. A separate written policy outlining the school’s policy is provided to each student and staff

Campus Security Report: Sofia University's campus security report is updated on an annual basis.
