Q: Can non-US citizens apply for financial aid?	A: Most U.S. citizens or eligible noncitizens are eligible for financial aid. Generally, if you have a "green card" (in other words, if you are a permanent resident alien), you will be considered an "eligible noncitizen" and will be able to get federal student aid if you meet the other basic eligibility criteria.  Canadian citizens should visit Student aid and education planning.
